Our Purpose and Approach

Kallam Anji Reddy Vidyalaya exists to ensure that children from every most background, including the underserved, can access quality education. Our approach is simple yet deliberate: meet each child where they are, give them the tools to learn, and nurture the confidence to use them well.

Classrooms are designed for active learning, where theory is reinforced through practical work, discussion, and collaboration. With a 30:1 student-teacher ratio, every student receives the attention needed to grow academically, socially, and emotionally.

Our teachers are central to this mission. They work with clear goals, continuous training, and a shared belief that learning is not only about academic achievement, but also about preparing young people to navigate life with resilience and integrity.





Key Highlights

Academic Outcomes

- 187 students appeared for the SSC Board Exams in April 2025, with a 100% pass result.
- 89% scored above a 7 GPA, and 3 students achieved a perfect 10 GPA.
- Transition to the CBSE curriculum began, ensuring alignment with NEP 2020 and preparing students for competency-based learning and national benchmarks.

Access and Inclusion

- KARV provides affordable education to all its students by charging subsidised fees, ensuring education remains within reach.
- 5% of students received financial support, including full waivers, with priority given to those from single-parent or low-income households.
- Inclusive infrastructure improvements, including ramps and lifts, ensured barrierfree access for differently-abled students and staff.

Holistic Development

- Leadership: Over 800 students participated in democratic council elections, gaining first-hand experience of accountability and representation.
- Vocational Training: Introduced prevocational modules that prepare students with practical skills for both life and work.
- Health & Safety: Awareness programs on POCSO, cyber safety, and substance abuse, alongside medical camps for staff and students, strengthened well-being.

Sports and Physical Education

- Students participated in zonal and national-level tournaments across volleyball, khokho, kabaddi, and football.
- The Girls' Under-16 Kho-Kho team won the Inter-School Championship.
- At the **National Football Championship** in Bangalore, KARV teams secured **runner-up positions**, with a student winning the **Golden Glove** Award for Best Goalkeeper.
- Structured training in yoga, mass PT, and team sports continued to build discipline, teamwork, and resilience.

STEM and Innovation

- The **Annual Science Exhibition** showcased 50 student projects under the theme of sustainability.
- At the **DRL Expo**, 40 students presented work before scientists, connecting school learning with real-world science.
- Through the Inqui-Lab Foundation "Think & Make" Program, students engaged in prototyping and entrepreneurship, with projects selected for the Teen Tycoons Launchpad 2025 at BITS Pilani.





Teacher Training and Leadership

- A week-long NEP training program equipped teachers with student-centred, 21stcentury pedagogy.
- CBSE Induction workshops trained 60 teachers and administrators in outcome-based learning.
- Leadership development was strengthened through the Teach Talks program in Samanvaya 2024–25, focused on AI in education and building future-ready schools.

Infrastructure Upgrades

- 100+ computers added to digital labs.
- Fully equipped Science and Mathematics labs, and a library of 10,500 books supporting independent study.
- Introduction of smart classrooms, enabling interactive and collaborative learning.
- Green initiatives such as waste management, solar energy, and eco club activities embedded sustainability into daily school practice.



Our Impact


