Agenda -1 : Curriculum review and approval for the Academic Year 2026-27

The curriculum plan for the academic year 2026–27 has been comprehensively reviewed and revised with the objective of strengthening teaching–learning practices and aligning them with academic standards. Different academic planners have been introduced to ensure structured lesson delivery and effective monitoring. New methods of assessment and their systematic implementation have been introduced for both students and staff to enhance academic outcomes and maintain uniform evaluation practices. Emphasis has been placed on adopting STEM-based teaching methodologies to promote analytical thinking and practical learning.

A differentiated approach has been developed for co-scholastic areas, with the introduction of structured planners for co-curricular activities incorporated into the school curriculum with a planned framework. To further enhance student competencies, a collaboration with **IIT Madras** has been initiated for **Class X students** to support skill development and exposure to advanced learning. Additionally, **Vedic Mathematics** has been introduced for **Classes I to V** to strengthen foundational numeracy skills.

Agenda -2 : Review and selection of textbooks in line with the curriculum

A detailed review of textbooks was conducted with the support of Heads of Departments and Coordinators to align content with students' learning capabilities. For the first time, practice books have been introduced for Classes VI to X to provide additional learning support for effective examination preparation and to reduce over-dependence on online and smart board-based teaching.

Agenda -3 : Status of CBSE Class –X Board Examination for the Academic Year 2025-26

As part of the arrangements for the CBSE Class X Board Examination total 168 students were enrolled. The examination center has been allotted at **CMR International School**, located at **Suraram Colony, Quthbullapur (M)**. The center has been officially designated with **Centre Code: 860338 (57666)**. The details of the examination center were placed before the School Management Committee for information and record. All necessary preparations and coordination related to the conduct of the examination at the said center are being carried out in accordance with CBSE guidelines.

Agenda -4 : Budget proposal for the Academic Year 2026-27

The budget for AY 2026–27 has been proposed to ensure quality education and adequately meet recurring staff and operational expenses. The enhanced allocation will support academic excellence, co-scholastic activities, infrastructure upgradation, maintenance and smooth operational management, enabling effective implementation of the school's academic and administrative plans.

Agenda -5 : Approval of the Fee SoP for the Academic Year 2026-27

Committee members discussed the proposed fee structure for the Academic Year 2026-27 and the same has been approved unanimously.

Agenda -6 : Staff Recruitment and CBSE Training Programmes

Further recruitment of required teaching staff will be carried out as per academic needs and subject-wise requirements. CBSE-mandated training and professional development programmes will continue to be scheduled and implemented periodically to strengthen teaching competencies and ensure continuous academic improvement.

Agenda -7 : Upgradation and improvement of infrastructure facilities

The newly introduced and upgraded infrastructure facilities have enhanced academic delivery, improved administrative efficiency, and strengthened student support services. Further assessment of infrastructure requirements for upgradation to Senior Secondary Level (Grade XII) will be planned and implemented as per academic, operational and CBSE requirements.

Agenda -8 : Digital TC Generation and School Software Dashboard

As per CBSE guidelines, manual Transfer Certificates (TCs) cannot be issued to students. In compliance, an **online TC format** has been designed and implemented for the current academic year. Furthermore, the **school software dashboard** has been upgraded across various operational modules to maintain accurate academic records for CBSE audits and reporting purposes. This system also aims to enhance coordination between **parents, students, and the Board**, ensuring transparency and efficiency in academic and administrative processes. The implementation and operational framework of the software dashboard were presented and discussed during the meetings.

Agenda -9 : Class- XI & XII affiliation Upgradation

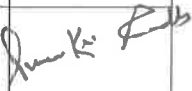
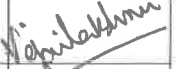
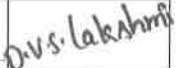
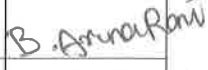
